Any Tutor/Trainer with:

- NZARBP membership,
- At least three years of industry experience
- Adult teaching qualifications or working towards adult teaching qualification
- No serious complaints received about their work to date

How do I enter this category?

1. Tell us about yourself - 15 points (maximum 1000 words)

- Describe your relevant experience, background and qualifications.
- What motivated and/or inspired you to choose a career in teaching/training and how do you stay current with industry practices?
- What are you doing to positively promote and/or support the beauty industry for the future?

2. Provide endorsements to support your application: Staff member; Student; Industry - 5 points

 Please provide minimum of 3 endorsements and their contact details for verification

3. Identify what makes you stand out – 25 points per example

- Give **two** (2) examples demonstrating effective teaching/training practices that have enhanced student/ apprentice learning and achievement.
- Provide information highlighting your academic/ training achievements, e.g. may include awards gained, mentoring role.

4. Provide us with a video of yourself - 30 points

• Video to include classroom set up, teaching environment and, where possible, a 2 min teaching demonstration

What happens next?

Entries must be received by **06 October 2023**. Any entries received after this date will not be accepted.

If you are a Finalist, you will receive notification via email by 03 November 2023.

Finalist interviews will be conducted via video conferencing, with dates to be confirmed.

All Finalists are expected to attend the Awards ceremony on **Saturday 24 February 2024** at the **Toto on Ascot, Ellerslie Events Centre, Auckland**. This is a formal event, and winners will be announced on the night.
